Daunting backlog

IT backlog is too big and growing fast. 38% of IT pros reported having 25 or more apps planned for the year.



App delivered doesn't meet expectations

Among the top 3 challenges that complicate or delay app delivery: Fuzzy or changing requirements.



Slow app delivery

Due to the backlog and back-and-forth on requirements, a simple change could take months. 37% of IT professionals say it takes 3-4 months to develop an app.

Employees are stuck with old, manual ways of work; don't have basic training to create their own workflows.





The concept of tapping into your business owners to build their own apps on an easy-to-use no-code/ low code platform.


Who is a Delegated Developer?

Process Owner

I'm responsible for a Business Process or Value Chain. It is my responsibility that this process runs as smooth as possible and that the people working on this process are facilitated in doing their job as efficiently as possible

I know the process in and out. I can point out exactly where the bottlenecks are in the process, and which manual activities take a lot of time. I know of each step in the process why we have it and why it is important

I can build an application that manages tasks which makes up the entire process. (e.g. Case or Request). By visualizing the steps in the process and preconfiguring templates the manual effort and hand-overs are reduced. This saves time, effort an minimizes risk of human errors



Business Analyst

I'm responsible for managing, manipulating and sharing **business data**. I gather data from multiple sources, work it **in Excel, MS Access** to give meaningful insights about what we are doing as a business and help measure **KPI's** and summarize them in **reports**

I have deep knowledge of our data, what it means and to whom it is relevant.

I frequently suggest improvements to our processes and decisions. I'm loaded with work because my organisation wants to be more "Data Driven", but most of my activities are repetitive creation of reports and data exports.

Given a platform that is rich in process data I can create applications that handle data and provide meaningful insights real-time. I can automate the tracking of KPIs, and build flows that pro-actively warn stakeholders if action is required. I can automate and streamline the requests for data exports and reports.



Scientist / Engineer (non-IT)

I can have background in Engineering or Science, and in my day-to-day job I'm used to solving complex problems. For my specific expertise I have the right specialist tools, (e.g 3D drawing software) but for the simpler tasks and processes I'm bound to outlook and Excel

I'm used to be able to optimize stuff and to think how to deal with problems the best way possible. I work with advanced technology all the time, so for me to apprehend a low-code platform is like a walk in the park. I'm also a costly employee, so allowing to organize my my work more effectively has a great return on investment.

I can build simple apps that simplify a process or that automate manual repetitive tasks. I can build flows that automatically complete requests, send out (bulk) emails, and keep stakeholders automatically informed. I can build apps that organize and visualize the structure of my team, product or project to more efficiently deliver value.





Why is governance so important?



Avoiding Shadow IT

Governance helps prevent the proliferation of unauthorized or unmonitored apps, reducing the risk of shadow IT and ensuring centralized control over IT assets.



Compliance and Security

Governance ensures that apps adhere to regulatory standards and maintain data security, reducing risks of non-compliance and breaches.




Consistency and Standardization

Governance maintains uniformity in app development processes, ensuring consistency across applications and reducing potential errors or inefficiencies.



Governance is key for success

There are 5 main areas where proper governance is of critical importance



Intake

Having a streamlined standardized intake process, is essential to keep the overview on a Delegated Developer developed application portfolio

Architecture

Future proof apps by applying architectural principles and safeguarding best practices

Delivery

Having a standardized delivery practice with design and build support ensures consistency and quality in delivery

Deployment

Automating and streamlining testing and deployment steps ensures consistency and quality and minimizes risk

Support

Also low-code apps need to be supported. Define a support model that balances the flexibility of Delegated Developer owned apps stability of enterprise grade IT support.





By using a common model where Delegated Developers are supported by the CoE and many automated DevOps controls you ensure quality and speed.









Govern low-code with app and developer visibility.




Delegated access


